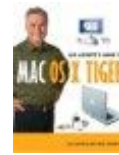

The screens are different but the biggest difference is storage. The PSP is limited to what you can get on a Memory Stick 2GB. Like all solid state devices the PSP gets much better. iPod is good for only a couple of hours.

Unfortunately, no single format works on both. For iPod use Quicktime Pro or the [Videora iPod Converter](#) to compress to MP4.
